## What is the WIOA program?

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) program that provides funding for job search and career counseling services to eligible adult and dislocated worker populations. In this personalized job search assistance program, participants have the opportunity to work one on one with career counselors to reach their employment goals.

Participants may be able to receive assistance with resumes, interview skills preparation and job referrals. Funding may also be available to assist with job related expenses as well as for target occupation trainings and certifications.

## How Do You Qualify?



There are different ways an individual may be eligible for WIOA services. You may qualify if you fit in to one of the following categories:

- **You are low income, receive TANF, SNAP or other public assistance**
- **Dislocated Worker- recently laid off and receiving unemployment benefits**
- **Separating military member**

**You will need to provide documents to verify the following:**

- **Proof of Age**
- **Authorization to work in the U.S.**
- **If male, proof of registration for selective service**
